MIXED and FAMILY BATHING on THURSDAYS,

from 2 p.m. to 9 p.m.

APRIL 30th to SEPTEMBER 24th, 1925.

REGULATIONS.

1. That the bath be cleared of general bathers before mixed bathing commences
2. That curtains be placed in front of dressing boxes used by bathers while mixed and family bathing is in progress.
3. That bathers enter and leave the water on that side of the bath only on which their dressing boxes are placed.
4. That no bather remain in the bath more than half an hour.
5. That all males wear the recognised university costume in addition to the ordinary bathing drawers supplied by the Council.
6. That all females wear an approved bathing costume.
7. **That no bather be admitted unless accompanied by a person of the opposite sex, except** in the case of children accompanied by their parents.
8. That a male and female attendant be on duty during the whole time mixed bathing is in progress.
9. That the entrance fee for adults be 1/- for each person and for children under 15 years of age (accompanied by their parents) 6d.
10. That **no** visitors be allowed.
